## Val di Fiemme: Arrival by Public Transport for Spectators

Val di Fiemme can be easily reached by train. The interchange point for continuing by bus is Ora railway station. From there, regional line 140 operated by südtirolmobil (Ora–Cavalese) and the extended line B101 of Trentino Trasporti (Ora–Cavalese–Penia) run regularly. On competition days, these services are supplemented by additional shuttle buses provided by the organiser.

The B101 line of Trentino Trasporti also serves, on South Tyrolean territory, the stops **Montan Dolomitenstraße / Montagna Via delle Dolomiti** , **Aldein Brücke / Ponte Aldino** , **Kaltenbrunn Abzweigung Truden / Fontanefredde Bivio Trodena**, and **San Lugano Kirche / San Lugano Chiesa** .

Spectators of the cross-country skiing and biathlon competitions using line B101 can get off at **Tesero, Piazza Battisti**, and continue with shuttle **TS02** to the cross-country stadium.

## Timetables

- Brenner railway line 100
- Trentino Trasporti, line B101 (Ora–Cavalese–Penia), valid from 5 to 15 March 2026
- Trentino Trasporti, shuttle TS02 (Tesero–Hub Lago di Tesero), valid from 5 to 15 March 2026

On competition days, the organiser also provides a free shuttle service from Ora railway station. The service operates about two and a half hours before the start of the competitions and connects directly to the venues of the Paralympic events in Tesero. It is recommended to use this service.

## Arrival by Car

For guests arriving by car, paid and reservation–required car parks are available (Molina Parking, Predazzo Bore Parking, Moena Bore Parking). The car parks are connected to the Lago di Tesero competition venue by dedicated shuttle services.
