Among vineyards, Dolomite peaks and historic villages, guests can discover the best wines, cheeses and specialities of Trentino-South Tyrol in three levels of experience: Bronze, Silver and Gold. Whether it's a guided cheese tasting in the Dolomites, a half-day wine tour through two regions or an exclusive day trip featuring fine wines and gourmet cuisine, each experience combines authentic flavours with breathtaking scenery.

## Wine & Taste Olympics Bronze

Val di Fiemme Dairy | 11.02. + 18.02. | 09am – 11:30am | The tour is in English

A pleasure in the true sense of the word, in the heart of the Dolomites. In a mountain dairy, participants can take part in a guided tour of cheese production, followed by a tasting of local cheeses. Two wines will be served, one from Trentino and one from South Tyrol, creating an authentic harmony between the aromas of the mountains.

## Wine & Taste Olympics Silver

Predazzo | 09.02. + 16.02. | 10am – 05pm | The tour is in English

An ideal experience for those who have little time available but do not want to miss out on the charm of Trentino-Alto Adige wines.

A half-day trip through the border areas where Trentino and South Tyrol meet, among vineyards, historic villages and fine wines. The excursion begins at a winery on the South Tyrolean Wine Road, where participants can learn about local winemaking and taste the region's wines. This is followed by a typical lunch at a local restaurant for an authentic all-round culinary experience. The tour then continues to Trentino, to Rotaliana Königsberg, where you will visit another winery and taste its wines.

## Wine & Taste Olympics Gold

Predazzo | 13.02. + 20.02. | 08am – 7pm | The tour is in English

An exclusive and comprehensive experience. The excursion begins at a winery with breathtaking views, where vineyards stretch across hills and mountains. Here, participants will learn about winemaking and taste the winery's finest wines, presented by expert sommeliers.

The tour continues along the South Tyrolean Wine Road to a winery with unique architecture, where design, innovation and tradition come together.

This is followed by lunch in a cellar in the Rotaliana plain. After lunch, there is another visit to a cellar. In the afternoon, the last stop is in the Cembra Valley, where impressive vineyards climb steep dry stone walls and produce fresh Müller-Thurgau and mineral Trentodoc sparkling wines, which are tasted in one of the valley's cosy cellars.
